JOB SUMMARY: Under the supervision of the Director of Nursing, Medical Director and the patient's physician, provides hemodialysis therapies to patients with chronic renal failure. Plans, provides and documents care provided to patients. Assures that the plan of care is carried out in a safe environment through performance and supervision of subordinate personnel. OSHA Bloodborne Pathogens Class I.

JOB QUALIFICATIONS:

- A. Education: Graduate of an accredited School of Professional Nursing.
- B. Personal Job-Related Skills: Effective oral and written communication skills.
- C. Licensure, Registry or Certification: Registered Nurse currently licensed by the State of Texas. BCLS.
- D. Experience:
 - 1. Prior Work Experience: One year experience as a professional Registered Nurse.
 - 2. Technical Training: Current CPR certification.
- E. Physical and Mental Requirements: Duties of the position require extended periods of standing and walking. Bending, stooping, twisting, reaching, and lifting up to 50 pounds. Occasional heavy lifting when moving or supporting patients who may suddenly become weak or helpless. Pushing or pulling heavy medical equipment (on wheels) weighing up to 200 pounds.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- A. Develops and implements the nursing process.
- B. Operates required hemodialysis equipment.
- C. Performs support function duties in the department.
- D. And other duties assigned.

OTHER SIGNIFICANT REQUIREMENTS:

- A. Maintains HIPAA required and all other confidentiality while working with confidential matters on a daily basis.
- B. Provides service direct to patients while maintaining a positive customer relations atmosphere.
- C. Interacts with patients, family members, Medical Staff members and other department managers on a continuous basis.
- D. Follows aseptic procedures and procedures for using precautions when involved in direct patient contact or handling potentially infectious materials.
- E. Performs duties in related departmental functions as directed by the Administrator or Department Supervisors.
- F. Follows safety guidelines and policies for the Hospital.
