JOB SUMMARY: Under the supervision of nursing staff members, physician assistants, nurse practitioners and physicians, EMT-I/ LVN, CNA assists in providing nursing emergency patient care, prepares records, and maintains clean environment. OSHA Bloodborne Pathogens Class I.

JOB QUALIFICATIONS:

- A. Education: High School graduate or equivalent.
LVN: Must have attended accredited program
- B. Personal Job-Related Skills: Ability to read and write effective oral and written communication skills and the ability to comprehend and follow verbal or written instructions.
- C. Licensure, Registry or Certification: EMT-I certification currently kept by the State of Texas. LVN must have a current Texas licensure. BCLS certification, ACLS, PALS, NRP, and TNCC certifications.
- D. CNA must have current CNA Certification & BLS certification.
- E. Experience:
 - 1. Prior Work Experience: One year's experience as In Field EMT-I or medical setting preferred. LVN must have at least one year of hospital experience.
 - 2. CNA must have at least one year of experience in a long-term or hospital setting.
 - 3. Technical Training: Certified EMT-I course. LVN attended an accredited program.

- F. Physical and Mental Requirements: Duties of the position require extended periods of standing and walking. Bending, stooping, twisting, reaching, and lifting to 50 pounds. Occasional heavy lifting when moving or supporting patients who may suddenly become weak or helpless.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- A. Completes basic physical and psychosocial assessment of patients and takes basic nursing histories to provide a basis for the development of patient care plans under the direct supervision of a licensed professional.
- B. Implements and monitors appropriate nursing care as directed by the physician or licensed nurse and ensure vital information is reported to the licensed nurse.
- C. Assures that each patient receives quality care.
- D. Maintains accurate and timely records according to hospital policy and procedures.
- E. And other duties assigned.

OTHER SIGNIFICANT REQUIREMENTS:

- A. Maintains HIPAA required and all the other confidentiality while working with confidential matters on a daily basis.
- B. Provides service direct to patients while maintaining a positive patient relations atmosphere.
- C. Follows aseptic procedures and precautions when involved in direct patient contact or handling potentially infectious materials.
- D. Performs duties in related departmental functions as directed by the Administrator or Department Supervisors. Willingly assists in anything being necessary for patient care or accomplishing the Hospital's mission.
- E. Assists with the development of departmental policies, procedures and practices and monitors for compliance and consistency once established.
- F. Follows safety guideline and policies for the Hospital.
